Sheridan's Amazon Direct Fulfillment model is a fully integrated, automated process of system-to-system signaling.

Here's how it works:

1. The Publisher receives the Amazon Direct Fulfillment orders from Amazon.
2. The Publisher captures these orders in their system.
3. The Publisher sends the orders to Sheridan via Sheridan Select™. Sheridan Select POD becomes your Amazon-compliant warehouse.
4. Sheridan processes the Amazon orders as POD.
5. Sheridan automatically generates a dynamic Amazon-branded packing slip using data from the order feed. This packing slip is included in the Amazon customer's order.
6. Sheridan ships the orders via Amazon's 3rd party shipping account number.
7. Sheridan sends an Amazon-compliant advanced ship notice (ASN) signal to the publisher and/or Amazon, completing the transaction.

This highly successful workflow is yielding increased POD orders year over year for our publishers.
